## **INVESTIGATIVE INFORMATION**

### **Case Synopsis**

FSRA - 71 y/o BM who was grasping the tow arm of a tow truck in motion, fell off, and was struck by the vehicle in tow. Pronounced on scene. Tow truck left scene and later returned without the vehicle that struck the decedent in tow.

### **Decedent Physical Exam**

Extensive trauma was noted of the head, with frontal bone exposure and fracturing. Brain matter was observed near the decedent head, torso, and lower extremities. Abrasions were observed of the lateral right face, lower back, and bilateral knees. Minimal manipulation was done on scene and all property left was left on the body. The body bag was sealed for transport.

### **Scene Observation**

FI N. Miller arrived on the scene located at 7400 S. Gessner Road, Houston, TX 77036 at 0804 on 5/2/19. S. Gessner Road was a highway with 3 northbound lanes and 3 southbound lanes. The decedent was located in the first southbound lane. The posted speed limit was 35 MPH. A tow truck, which was a red Dodge Ram 4500 (TO8 78K) was photographed on scene. The vehicle, which was reported to be in tow during the incident, was not on scene to be photographed. There were no EtOH, tobacco, or illicit drugs found on scene. The bag was sealed on scene. The ambient temperature was 79.3°F with 57% humidity. The scene was exited at 9:48am.

### **Narrative**

Per Officer M. Tamez (HPD), the decedent resided at the apartment complex near the incident location at 7400 South Gessner Road, Houston, Tx 77036. On the morning of 5/2/19, the decedent's vehicle was in the process of being towed. Following a verbal altercation with the tow truck driver, the decedent grasped onto the tow arm of the truck as the driver of the truck was departing with the vehicle. The decedent fell from his grasp and was struck by the vehicle in tow on South Gessner Road. The tow truck and vehicle left the scene. A witness called 911 and HFD E10 was dispatched to the location at 7:19am and pronounced the decedent at 7:28am. It was unclear if the tow truck driver was aware of the decedent's presence on the vehicle. The area was well lit at the time of the incident and road conditions were clear with no construction in the area. The speed limit on South Gessner Road is 35mph. It was unknown what the tow truck's speed was at the time of the incident.

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The tow truck and driver later returned to the scene (photographed); however, the vehicle in tow, which struck the decedent, remained at the Harris County Impound and was not brought back on scene. HPD was in the process of locating and photographing the vehicle at the time of this report. HPD reports there was also possible surveillance in the area. Officer M. Tamez reported he would supply any surveillance video and photographs of the vehicle in impound to HCIFS.

HPD investigation was on going at the time of this report and it was yet to be determined if the case was to be worked as a homicide or accident. Officer M. Tamez requested to attend the exam due to the unclear circumstanced. 1 hour lead time was requested.
